The Lyonesse Child & Family Europe association supports two charity projects in Romania

The charitable association “Lyonesse Child & Family Europe“ successfully supported two Romanian facilities for disadvantaged children and young people. A hospital school in Busteni and the ASTRU House near Cluj were newly equipped and completely renovated with the help of the association. Both facilities were inaugurated in October.

Romania, 14th November 2013. In mid-October, the director of the Lyonesse Child & Family Foundation, Nina Passegger, and her team officially opened the hospital school in Busteni, a small town 130 km north of Bukarest. The „Lyonesse Child & Family Europe“ association had renovated the school, equipped the classrooms and provided approximately 100 children with school material. The hospital school in Busteni is a health care institution, which provides a learning programme for its young patients. This enables sick children who have to stay in hospital for a long time to continue their education.

Shortly afterwards the ASTRU House in Dăbâca near Cluj was officially opened. At the ceremony Nina Passegger, a Lyonesse team, the director of the local primary school, Florina Macavei, and the mayor of Dăbâca, Valer Petrindean, were present. The costs of the renovations were borne by the „Lyonesse Child & Family Europe“ association. The building was also equipped with furniture such as tables and chairs. The ASTRU House is being run by the organisation “Asociația Tineretului Român Unit” in order to give socially disadvantaged children the opportunity to meet and talk to each other. „I am very thankful for the donations. The children now have a beautiful and functional place for themselves”, Petrindean happily tells us.
