Our mission

According to the motto "Education. Opportunities. Future." the Child & Family Foundation has supported and implemented around 90 relief and education projects in 40 countries over the last few years and has thereby significantly changed the lives of thousands of children and their families. The foundation therefore places a great focus on the fields of education, educational support and adult education as well as creating awareness, promoting equal opportunities and offering immediate aid.

In accordance with the guideline "Education for all" the Child & Family Foundation provides the means to education by building schools for those living in disadvantaged areas across the globe. It also promotes the protection of the rights of children and families, creates access to education and supports centres of education. The aim of the foundation, its members, employees and supporters is to help people help themselves.

In addition, the Child & Family Foundation provides material and financial aid in disaster areas as well as for projects that aim to improve the livelihood of people in need and that offer immediate relief. Another objective of the Child & Family Foundation is to bridge the gap between prevention work and sustainability in educational support.

The Child & Family Foundation's work is financed through contributions in the form of donations as well as sponsorships from companies and private persons.

An essential component of the entire financial resources stems from the myWorld group of companies, who set the yearly budget for the Child & Family Foundation to realise their projects and cover their administrative costs. The yearly budget amount is dependent upon the success of the corporate group's various business areas.

Aid and education projects across the globe

School Projects

Over the last few years, the Child & Family Foundation has set up countless education projects in every corner of the globe – particularly in places where poorer members of society are not guaranteed access to an education.

Honduras

As numerous children in Honduras are not granted access to an education, the Child & Family Foundation decided to establish the Escuela Lyoness on the outskirts of the port of La Ceiba. Children from the surrounding poor neighbourhoods have been attending the school since 2012. The Child & Family Foundation bears all the costs for running the school.

Philippines

The entire complex at the San Roque Elementary School, including six existing buildings, was renovated on the island of Southern Leyte. The Child & Family Foundation also established a Health & Nutrition Program and a hygiene Program with the aim of combating malnutrition in the region.

South Africa

With the support of Nelson Mandela's family, the Child & Family Foundation has successfully renovated the damaged primary school in the South African village of Qunu, the birthplace of the country's famous leader. Classes in the new building began in 2013. As well as classrooms and a nursery school, the building also houses a computer room, a library, washrooms, a staff room and offices. At the beginning of 2016, the school sustained heavy damage in a hurricane. However, thanks to the Child & Family Foundation, it was possible to finish the repair work in only a short space of time.

India

The Dhara Children Academy in Thakurdwara, India, received extensive renovations thanks to the Child & Family Foundation. Approximately 150 students from various castes are now benefitting from the improvements to the derelict rooms and from the installation of a heating system as well as new windows. Furthermore, the Dhara Children Academy will receive long-term support from the Child & Family Foundation in order to maintain an ongoing school operation.

Nigeria

The Child & Family Foundation is currently supporting two school projects in Nigeria. The Holy Trinity School in Uromi has been completely renovated and extended. Since then, the Child & Family Foundation has been supporting operations at the school by purchasing items needed for everyday life and improving the standard of education at the school. In Jos, the Child & Family Foundation has been working with the Amina Zwindila Foundation School. The Child & Family Foundation has been helping to improve the small primary school's infrastructure and supporting day-to-day life at the school since 2012.

Mexico

Escuela para el Futuro is a private school for children in need that is financed through donations and forms the social centre of the poverty-stricken suburb San Juan De Abajo, close to the city of León. The Child & Family Foundation is supporting the people from this region on site by extending the school to include a pre-school and a nursery with a large garden and play area so that the 130 children can have an improved outlook on life.



Educational projects and immediate relief

The Child & Family Foundation has also been making its mark in the field of educational support and immediate aid in a number of different countries. Exemplary in this regard are the projects in Brazil, United Kingdom and Croatia:

Since 2012, young women in Parajuru, Brazil, have been taking part in "Projeto Textil" getting the chance to learn more about tailoring, establish an independent career and earn money for their families.

Thanks to the collaboration with the organisation "Potential Mentoring" the Child & Family Foundation is helping adolescents who are at risk of expulsion from school, social exclusion or delinquency regain control over their lives.

For the children lovingly looked after in the Ladimirevci children's home in Croatia, the Child & Family Foundation could purchase some much-needed beds, bed frames and mattresses thanks to the support of numerous voluntary helpers.

Angel for a Day

Since 2013, the "Angel for a Day" charity campaigns have provided help to those in need who are often not able to afford the things we take for granted. For one day, voluntary helpers from the myWorld Community come together to create an unforgettable day for children, adolescents and families in their vicinity and to provide them with much needed relief supplies.
